On March 29, Redskins signed CB Phillip Buchanon and picked up Willie Parker from the Steelers. He is a very good Running Back. Redskins also signed a punter, Josh Bidwell, who is 34 years old and had 6 seasons at Tampa Bay and 4 years in Green Bay.

OVERTIME CHANGES
